The Custom show on Subcity Radio has become well known for its diverse yet specialist playlists, with producer and presenter Dj NoFACE playing anything from drum n bass, electro, dubstep, hip hop to reggae.

The Custom show features some of Scotland's finest talent from the thriving underground scene with regular bi-weekly guest appearances. Previous guest's have included Scotland's top drum n bass producer J Bostron (Hi Fi Drum records, Audio bullet Records), Edinburgh's Professor Fresh (Pangea Nation, The Infekted, Capitol 1212) and UK Turntable legend Dj Krash Slaughta (UK DMC Finalist 2006)

Everything is done to keep the custom play list fresh and exclusive. Spending all his free time digging through record shops, searching through forums and websites such as www.sdnb.co.uk, www.dubstepforum.com, www.raggajungle.bz, www.myspace.com (to list just a few) and by personally contacting producers and record labels across the globe, NoFace is making the effort to source the latest tracks. Many tracks are getting their first play outside the recording studio on the Custom show.

The Custom show has gained a reputation for being a platform for underground music. This has led to producers, labels and djs alike approaching Custom with requests to play their music on Subcity radio.

What is more is that NoFACE and guests often play live sets from within the Subcity studio, which showcase's the absolute best in Scottish music production as well as defining Custom as one of the most unique and exciting student radio shows.

Since his beginning at Subcity radio, NoFACE has gone from strength to strength, headlining club nights and appearing at music festivals all over the U.K, such as Lockdown, Wickerman festival, Street Knowledge and Connect festival alongside artists such as Coldcut, Fabio, Mungos Hifi, Soom T, Dj Bunty and Krash Slaughta. With many more gigs on the horizon, as well as more releases on Dub Bullet Records with his own productions, Dj NoFACE is flying the flag for Scotland and Subcity Radio.
