Punk at heart, opinionated, passionate and prejudiced only against those who seek to discriminate, She Said is driven by a DIY ethic and absolute commitment to all forms of noisiness. And yet from time to time, She Said reveals its quieter, gentler side and will snuggle in to show its softer side. Always intelligent, always informative, frequently suggestive, She Said doesn't do sitting on the fence but will challenge, entertain, amuse and arouse in equal proportions.

## **She Said Come Ahead If You Think You're Punk Enough!**

In only the second year of the show, She Said has steadily built its reputation and audience base largely through social networking, e-mail lists and word on the street. An engaging and eclectic blend of music from the vibrant Glasgow DIY scene is balanced with classic punk, alternative and independent noise from home and away. Critically, the She Said team's constant presence on the gig circuit, at alternative festivals (including ATP, Supersonic and Primavera) its relationship with promoters and outright damn niceness has ensured the strongest line-up of guests on Subcity's schedule. In the past year these have included Stuart Braithwaite from Mogwai and Rock Action artists Errors and Remember Remember. In keeping with the show's DIY ethic, local independent labels and promoters appearing included Predestination Records, Electropapknit Bookings and Synergy Concerts. Storming left of field (literally!) sprinted broadcaster and Scotland footballing legend Pat Nevin, clearly demonstrating the team's reach when it comes to diversity and quality. Whilst many hours and months are spent nurturing potential guests, increasingly the show has been approached by local artists and labels keen to offer their services.

She Said's approach to programme production is informal, intuitive and structured first and foremost around the music. Guests have significant autonomy with the playlist and bring their own experience and perspective to the show. Considerable emphasis is placed in nurturing the on-air relationship with guests to ensure they are relaxed and give their best to the show, a task assisted by the closeness of presenters Derek and Allan's own relationship. The unexpected, the unintended and occasional moments of chaos are embraced in a manner the late and mighty John Peel would have most certainly approved of!

She Said is not just a fan of the alternative scene, but an integral part, and a known member of the community among bands and fans alike throughout Glasgow. It is this that has allowed them to lead the way in showcasing the Glasgow punk and rock scenes.

As the legend of She Said grows, the team will not countenance complacency at the expense of continually striving to bring the finest of noise to Subcity's schedule.
